Invitation to Submit Indicative Nominations for Long Term Capacity at Non-Exempt Port Terminals: Mackay, Gladstone, and Portland

I am pleased to advise that GrainCorp is this week inviting Indicative Nominations for Long Term Capacity at GrainCorp's Non-Exempt Port Terminals for the period 1 October 2025 to 30 September 2028.

The assessment of Indicative Nominations for Long-Term Capacity will be undertaken in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in GrainCorp's Bulk Wheat and Bulk Grain (Non-Wheat) Port Terminal Services Protocols which can be found on GrainCorp's website via the following link:

The purpose of this letter is to formally extend an invitation to you to nominate your Indicative Long-Term Capacity volumes for the three-year period commencing 1 October 2025.

The Indicative Long-Term Capacity Nomination period will open 9:00am Monday, 24 February 2025 and will close at 5.00pm Friday, 7 March 2025.

NEXT STEPS:

- GrainCorp invites customers to submit their Indicative Nominations for Non-Exempt Port Terminal LTA Long-Term Capacity for the three-year LTA term. This letter serves as notice of opening 9:00am Monday, 24 February 2025.
- GrainCorp closes the Indicative Long-Term Capacity Nomination period at 5.00pm Friday, 7 March 2025.
- GrainCorp reviews consolidated nominations, applies non-discriminatory pro-rata reductions if required and negotiates final volumes with customers. This will be undertaken within a maximum of 40 business days from closure of invitations.

If agreement is reached, the customer is offered a Long-Term Agreement with GrainCorp.
